DEADLINE: Monday, September 20, 2010

Cal Alumni Pride, formerly known as UCGALA, chartered in 1986, is the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender (LGBT) alumni club of the University of California, Berkeley. Our mission is to support and promote the interests of UC Berkeley and its alumni, with an emphasis on issues and interests specific to the LGBT community. One of Cal Alumni Pride's major objectives is to serve as a resource to LGBT undergraduate students in the form of mentorship and scholarship resources. Scholarships are awarded to entering or continuing undergraduate students based on academic achievement and leadership criteria. The scholarships recognize students who have demonstrated leadership and community involvement who are lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgendered, or supportive of LGBT issues.

All undergrad students, regardless of gender identity or orientation, are encouraged to apply if they meet the eligibility criteria.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

You must be currently enrolled at the university, carrying a minimum 12 units per semester. Awards are paid on a per-semester basis and based on leadership potential and contribution to the LGBT community. If you are not registered for one of the semesters, you will receive half of the award. Scholarship recipients will also be invited to become a Cal Alumni Pride Ambassador, acting as liaisons between the organization and LGBT student groups on campus.

APPLICATION PACKAGE

A complete application package must include the following:

- A signed Cal Alumni Pride Scholarship Application
 - A copy of your current resume
 - A copy of your academic transcript (either official or unofficial)
 - A printout of your current schedule of classes
 - Response to the following questions (each essay should be no more than two pages long, double-spaces with 12-point font):
1. Discuss how your current leadership activities have helped with the advancement of the LGBT community?
 2. What is the biggest challenge that the LGBT community is facing today? How would your career goals mitigate these challenges and help promote the advancement of the LGBT community?
 3. Optional– Please share with us any special circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance.
